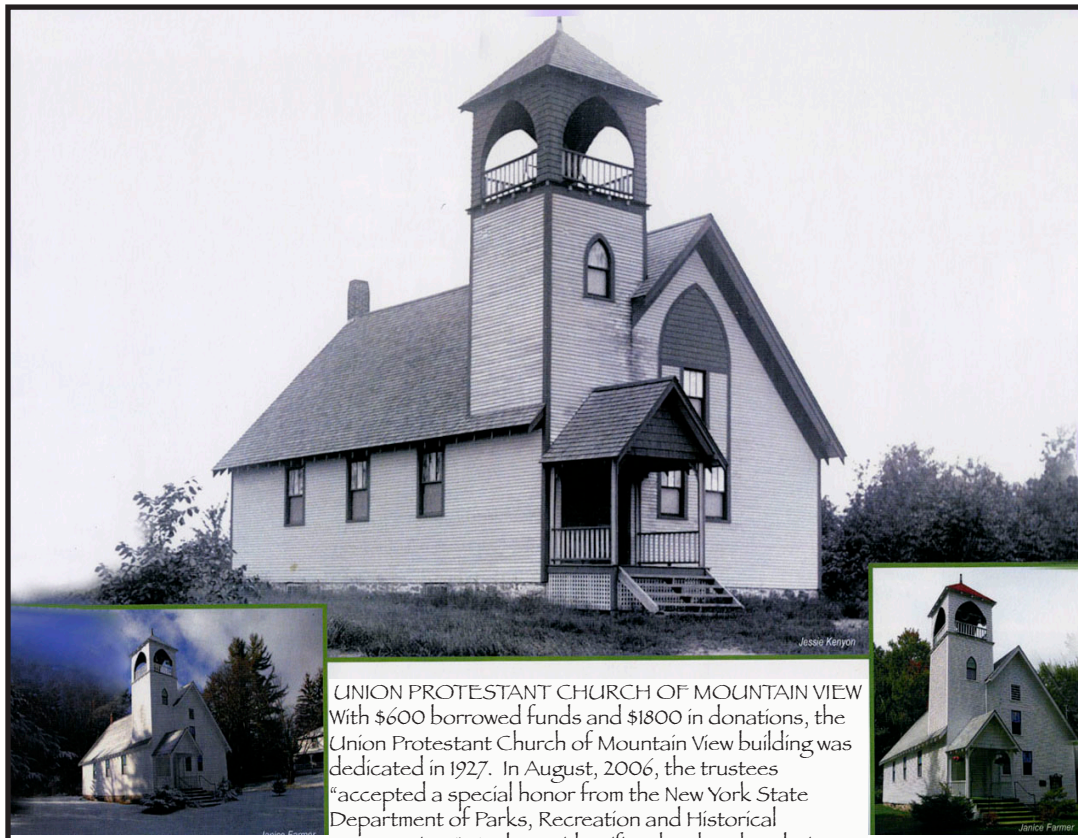


UNION PROTESTANT CHURCH OF MOUNTAIN VIEW 1916

With \$600 borrowed funds and \$1800 in donations, the Union Protestant Church of Mountain View building was dedicated in 1927.
